2. All pullets must be project animals received through the Poultry Project in March.
3. Each exhibitor is required to bring the 6 best pullets from their flock of 25.
4. Birds must arrive by 3:30 p.m. Tuesday, August 7.
5. Birds will be graded as blue, red or white ribbon pullets according to the 4-H Poultry Handbook.
6. Participants will turn their record books in at the time of the poultry show.
7. No auction after show.
