Rules and Regulations for ALL Pageants . Each pageant also has its own individual rules.

- Registration & practice for contestants ages 0-15 yrs. will be held on Sunday August 2nd from 2-4 p.m. at the Gibson County Fairgrounds in the Lowery Building. All contestants must fill out an entry form during or before practice Sunday, August 2nd. If not registered, the entry fee will be \$25 payable at the door the night of the pageants. (for Babes in Arms - 15 yrs. age groups only).
- Practice for Miss Fairest of the Fair will be held on Friday, July 31st from 6:30-7:30 p.m. at the Gibson County Fairgrounds in the Lowery Building.
- Deadline for registration will be 10a.m. on Saturday August 1st. All practices and pageants will be held at the Gibson County Fairgrounds in the Lowery Building. Miss Gibson County Fair participants will be given their interview times at 10:00A.M on Saturday August 1st.
- CASH or MONEY ORDER only. NO CHECKS accepted. No refunds will be issued.
- If the contestant won king or queen in the 2008 Gibson County Fair pageants, or represented the Gibson County Fair in the West TN Strawberry Festival, they are ineligible to compete again until they change age groups.
- While Little Miss Gibson County Fair, Teen Miss Gibson County Fair, and Miss Gibson County Fair will be eligible to compete in the Strawberry Festival Territorial Revue, The Gibson County Fair will not be responsible for any cart/wagon/float for the Strawberry Festival, Teapot Festival or any Territorial Revues fees or any fees associated with participation in these events .
