

2009 Miss Gibson County Fairest of the Fair

Ages 16-20, Girls Only

Saturday, August 1st, 1 p.m.

1. Entry fee is \$30 per contestant. NO CHECKS will be accepted! CASH or MONEY ORDER ONLY!
2. The contestant must have reached her 16th birthday, but not her 21st birthday by December 31, 2009.
3. The contestant cannot qualify if she has ever been married, had a child or found guilty of a felony. The contestant must currently and always have been of the female gender.
4. Gown must be formal and floor length. No exposed midriff. Contestant will not be allowed to carry flowers during the judging of the contest.
5. All contestants in the 2009 Miss Gibson County Fair Pageant may attend practice on Friday, July 31st, from 6:30-7:30 p.m. Deadline for registration will be at 10 a.m. August 1st, by calling to register 742-4606 or 234-3549. If not registered by this date and time, we will not accept any late entries at the door the afternoon of the pageant.
6. Interviews will be held on Saturday morning, August 1st, at 11 a.m. Interview Times will be given to all contestants at 10:00 a.m. Saturday August 1st. Attire should consist of a dress or business type suit.
7. Judging will consist of 50% beauty and 50% interview.
8. **Must be a resident of Gibson, Crockett or Weakley Counties.**
9. Miss Gibson County Fair must compete in the State Fairest of the Fair competition in Nashville, in January of 2010. (Contestant may participate in the State Pageant only one time.) The Gibson County Fair Association will pay for the room and entry fee for the Queen only. All of Miss Gibson County Fair's friends and family will be responsible for purchasing in advance State Pageant and Banquet Tickets. If the 2009 Miss Gibson County Fairest of the Fair does not participate in the State Fairest of the Fair competition in January of 2010 she will be responsible for reimbursing the Gibson County Fair Association all entry fees to the State Fairest of the Fair Competition, Pageant and Banquet tickets purchased and the room fees that were paid for the Queen and any deposits or pre-payments made by the Gibson County Fair Association on behalf of the Queen's family and friends.
10. Miss Gibson County Fair will be eligible to compete in the Strawberry Festival parade and Territorial Revue in Humboldt. The Gibson County Fair will not be responsible for cart/wagon/ float etc. or any fees associated with participation in the Strawberry Festival Parade or Territorial Review.
11. Miss Gibson County Fair will be expected to participate in various events during the 2009 Gibson County Fair.
12. The queen's parent/guardian will be responsible for the vehicle and fees for all parades and fees for the Strawberry Festival Pageant.
13. 2009 Miss Gibson County Fair must participate at the Jr. Market Livestock Show handing out ribbons Monday, August 3rd at 10 a.m. and participate at the Rodeo Friday and Saturday nights. Queen must be at the Rodeo entrance no later than 7:30 p.m.
14. If, for some reason, she cannot complete the aforementioned rules, she will relinquish all rights (crown, banner, scepter and trophy) as 2009 Miss Gibson County Fair and the first maid will therein become Queen.
15. A contestant may not represent more than one fair in any given year.
